They are interested in getting in contact with companies for MOSS (Modern Operating Systems Simulators) development of MiniApps (Mini Application Software) around the platform described to reach technical cooperation agreements.

Description

A Spanish SME very active in the field of ICT and settled in a Technology & Science Park has developed a technology platform for social media collaboration.

This platform integrates all processes regarding to information, communication and knowledge management of Communities of Practice.

The platform is developed to 100% on Open Source and web 2.0.

The company is interested in reaching agreements for technical cooperation with other entities of the ICT sector in order to develop / create miniapps that can be exploited in the 5 existing Operating Systems for Mobile: iPhone, Android, Symbian, Palm and Blackberry.

The miniapp model may contain a menu of at least 9 processes forming the activities that the member of the community will be able to perform in remote control mode. Therefore, it will be necessary to update the information that is spread in every of the modules that the user is signed in according to its profile in the community.

50% of these processes belong to publication and the rest require interaction and data entry by the user.
